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## **The Extracurricular Activity in the Development of the Literary Gifted Students**

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It's extremely difficult to develop creative abilities of gifted students in practice because the methodic of the work with them is insufficiently elaborated and often exist only on papers. Analysis of psychological and educational researches made it possible to identify the literary abilities as a special type of giftedness that are especially actively develop in adolescence, and extracurricular activities as one of the most effective ways of development.

In our opinion, the most important for extracurricular activities with literary gifted students are:

- Carried out in their spare time;
- The voluntariness, initiative and the activity for all participants;
- The lack of coercion and assessment system;
- Free choice of the types and forms of activity;
- Flexibility and variability of this activity which are focused on the development of creativity;
- Greater openness, spontaneity and informality of communication;
- The possibility of self-determination and self-identity;
- The practical activity orientation of the extracurricular activities and their implementation on the basis of individually oriented approach.
