“Integration of Ukraine in the International Scientific and Education Space”

The recent fundamental changes passed in Ukrainian society and changes in the European and world security perspectives, has revealed the demand on the new vision of the future of Ukrainian Science and Education as a part of global international system. One of the obvious tools for the implementation of this process is the mobility of scientists and students, support and development of international scientific networks, efficiency of scholarship programs.

Since times of Yaroslav the Wise, as well as, during the Soviet times, Ukraine was always the country with highly educated and qualified population. From this point of view the high quality human resources might be the source of prosperity in Ukrainian economy.

In spite of great scientific and educational potential we see the low involvement of Ukrainian scientists and students in the international projects. This means that Ukrainian research and education system required principally new approaches to the science politics and in particular in the sphere of international scientific cooperation.

This is the motivation to initiate Round Table Discussion for the exchange of experience and approaches to the problem of Triple Relations: Education – Science – Society in view of analyzing existing European structures and development of new instruments.

Main topics of Round Table are:

- Mobility of Ukrainian scientists through international programs: problems, perspectives, tasks;
- Experience of organization of science and education in European countries.



To the Round Table there are invited the experts and active participants of these processes with the aim to discuss and analyze the present situation and propose the adequate recommendations and measures.

To the discussion there are invited the Ukrainian scientists working in the field of Science of Science and Science of Education, Ukrainian authorities as well as German organizations involved in the science and education policy and management, Alexander von Humboldt Foundation, DAAD, DFG, BMBF.
